News Headlines


- Latest figures show over 12.93M confirmed cases of the coronavirus worldwide with over 569K deaths. Concern continues to grow over the surge of new cases in the U.S. which now has over 3.3M confirmed cases with over 135K deaths. CT has over 47K cases and 4,348 associated deaths.
- Florida reported nearly 15,300 new cases on Sunday, the highest single day total for any U.S. state since the pandemic began.

Economic News

- The (ISM) Non-manufacturing Index reading for the month of June rose 11.7 points to 57.1, signaling strong expansion in the U.S. service sector.
- The U.S. DOL's report on new jobless claims for the week ending July 4 came in at 1,314,000, down 99,000 from the prior week's revised level of 1,413,000.
- CT Governor Ned Lamont decided to delay phase 3 of the reopening last week due to the spike of cases around the country.
